

The Lessons

FIRST READING: Numbers 21:4-9

The people sit.

A Reading from the book of Numbers.

⁴From Mount Hor they set out by the way to the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; but the people became impatient on the way. ⁵The people spoke against God and against Moses, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and we detest this miserable food." ⁶Then the LORD sent poisonous serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so that many Israelites died. ⁷The people came to Moses and said, "We have sinned by speaking against the LORD and against you; pray to the LORD to take away the serpents from us." So Moses prayed for the people. ⁸And the LORD said to Moses, "Make a poisonous serpent, and set it on a pole; and everyone who is bitten shall look at it and live." ⁹So Moses made a serpent of bronze, and put it upon a pole; and whenever a serpent bit someone, that person would look at the serpent of bronze and live.

Reader The Word of the Lord. People *Thanks be to God.*

PSALM: Psalm 107:1-3, 17-22

Remain seated.

Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, * and his mercy endures for ever.

²Let all those whom the LORD has redeemed proclaim * that he redeemed them from the hand of the foe.

³He gathered them out of the lands; * from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south.

¹⁷Some were fools and took to rebellious ways; * they were afflicted because of their sins.

¹⁸They abhorred all manner of food * and drew near to death's door.

- ¹⁹Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, * and he delivered them from their distress.
- ²⁰He sent forth his word and healed them * and saved them from the grave.
- ²¹Let them give thanks to the LORD for his mercy * and the wonders he does for his children.
- ²²Let them offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving * and tell of his acts with shouts of joy.

A Reading from Paul's letter to the Church in Ephesus.


¹You were dead through the trespasses and sins ²in which you once lived, following the course of this world, following the ruler of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work among those who are disobedient. ³All of us once lived among them in the passions of our flesh, following the desires of flesh and senses, and we were by nature children of wrath, like everyone else. ⁴But God, who is rich in mercy, out of the great love with which he loved us ⁵even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—⁵and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁵so that in the ages to come he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁵For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God—⁵not the result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹oFor we are what he has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand to be our way of life.

¹⁷"Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. ¹⁸Those who believe in him are not condemned; but those who do not believe are condemned already, because they have not believed in the name of the only Son of God. ¹⁹And this is the judgment, that the light has come into the world, and people loved darkness rather than light because their deeds were evil. ²⁰For all who do evil hate the light and do not come to the light, so that their deeds may not be exposed. ²¹But those who do what is true come to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that their deeds have been done in God."

THE HOMILY

THE CREED

We believe in one God,

THE WELCOMING RITE FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION STUDENTS

Who presents these children to begin their spiritual journey toward Holy Communion? Presenter says: **I do**.

P: Receive the sign of the cross on your forehead. It is Christ himself who now strengthens you with this sign of his love. Learn to know and follow him.

A: Christ will be your strength! Learn to know and follow him!

P: Receive the sign of the cross on your ears, that you may hear the voice of the Lord.

A: Christ will be your strength! Learn to know and follow him!

P: Receive the sign of the cross on your eyes, that you may see the glory of God.

A: Christ will be your strength! Learn to know and follow him!

P: Receive the sign of the cross on your lips, that you may respond to the word of God.

A: Christ will be your strength! Learn to know and follow him!

P: Receive the sign of the cross over your heart, that Christ may dwell there by faith.

A: Christ will be your strength! Learn to know and follow him!

P: Receive the sign of the cross on your shoulders, that you may bear the gentle yoke of Christ.

A: Christ will be your strength! Learn to know and follow him!

P: Receive the sign of the cross on your hands, that Christ may be known in the work which you do.

A: Christ will be your strength! Learn to know and follow him!

P: I sign you with the sign of eternal life, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

A: Amen.



It is right, and a good and joyful thing, always and everywhere to give thanks to you, Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.



The Presider continues

Holy and gracious Father: In your infinite love you made us for yourself; and, when we had fallen into sin and become subject to evil and death, you, in your mercy, sent Jesus Christ, your only and eternal Son, to share our human nature, to live and die as one of us, to reconcile us to you, the God and Father of all.

He stretched out his arms upon the cross, and offered himself in obedience to your will, a perfect sacrifice for the whole world.

On the night he was handed over to suffering and death, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks to you, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, and said, "Take, eat: This is my Body, which is given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me."

After supper he took the cup of wine; and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, and said, "Drink this, all of you: This is my Blood of the new Covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this for the remembrance of me."

Therefore we proclaim the mystery of faith:

Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

We celebrate the memorial of our redemption, O Father, in this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving. Recalling his death, resurrection, and ascension, we offer you these gifts.

Sanctify them by your Holy Spirit to be for your people the Body and Blood of your Son, the holy food and drink of new and unending life in him. Sanctify us also that we may faithfully receive this holy Sacrament, and serve you in unity, constancy, and peace; and at the last day bring us with all your saints into the joy of your eternal kingdom.

All this we ask through your Son Jesus Christ. By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and for ever. *AMEN*.




The Breaking of the Bread

Prayed by people at home while the people present take communion


God of infinite mercy,

In the risen life of our savior. Amen


